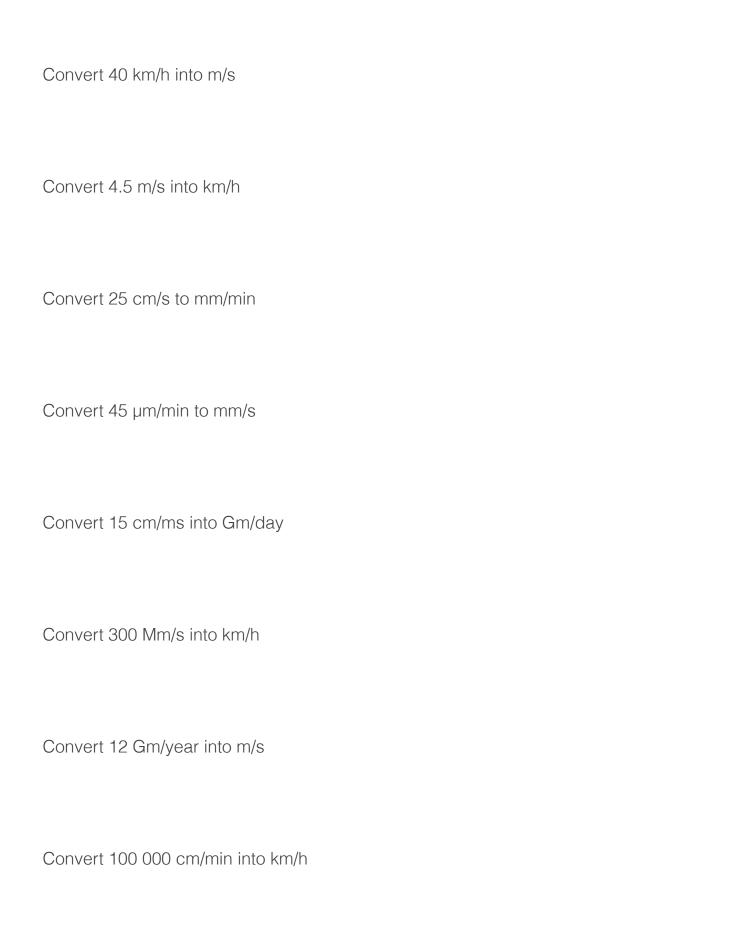

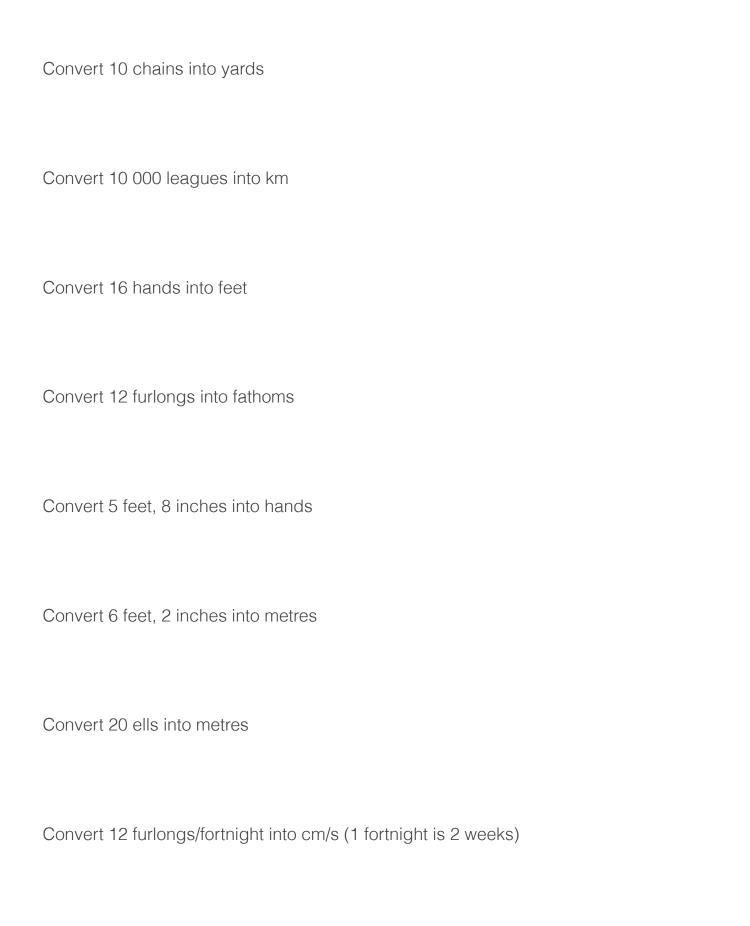
Convert 250 poppyseeds to nails

$$250 \text{ poppyseeds} \times \frac{1 \text{ barleycorn}}{4 \text{ poppyseeds}} \times \frac{1 \text{ inch}}{3 \text{ barleycorns}} \times \frac{1 \text{ digit}}{\sqrt[3]{4} \text{ inch}} \times \frac{1 \text{ nail}}{3 \text{ digits}} = 9.259259 \text{ nails} \approx 9.3 \text{ nails}$$
